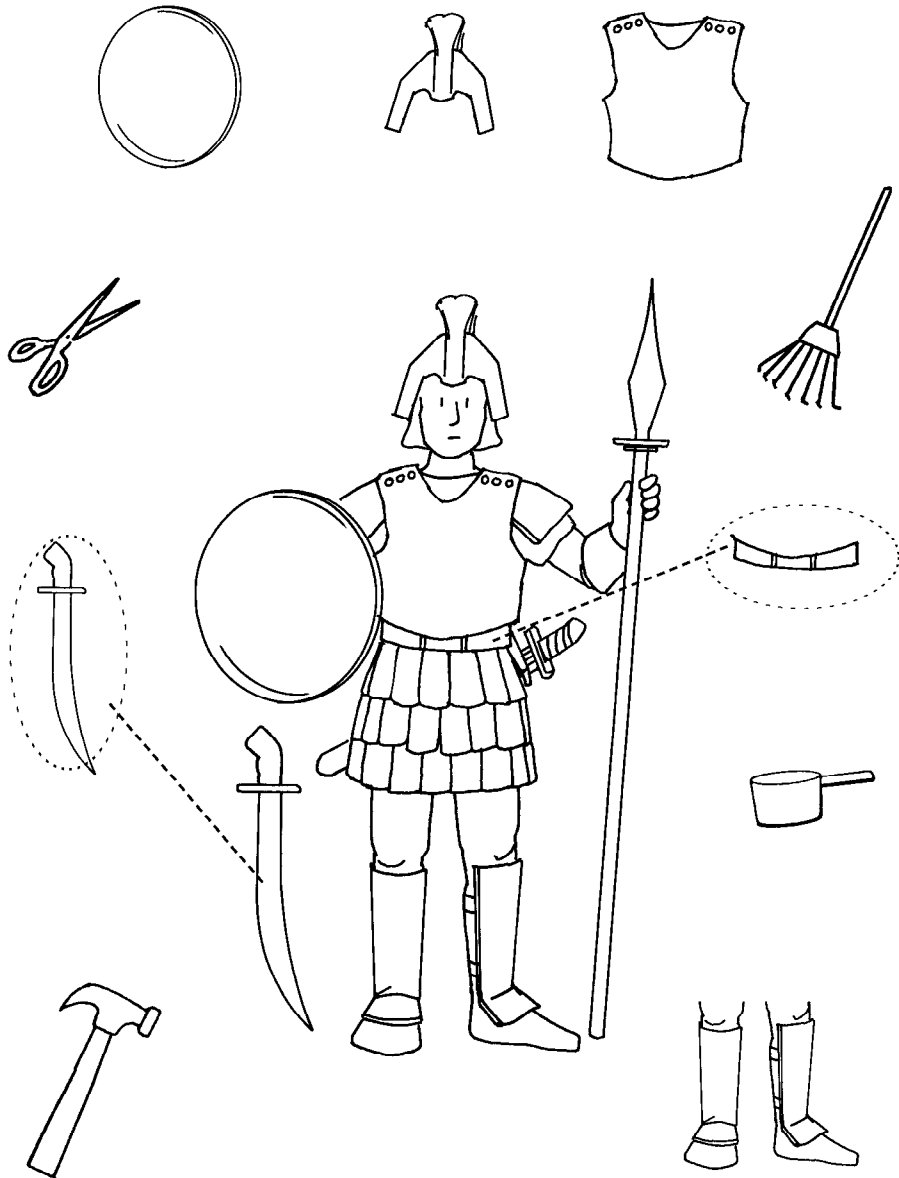





Put on the full armor of God.
