Our men will **NOT** meet this **Wednesday** night at Starbucks. We will get started back Wednesday, June 20.



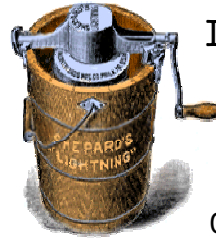

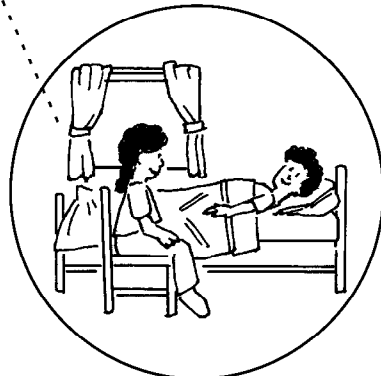
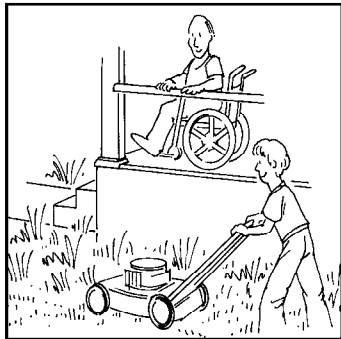
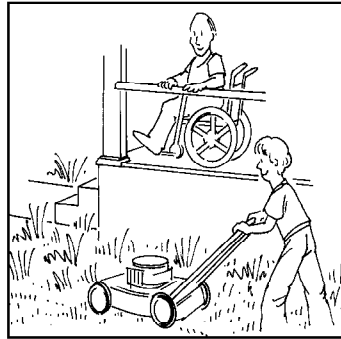
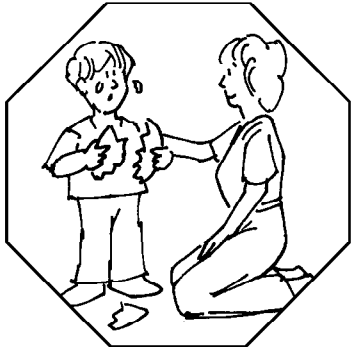
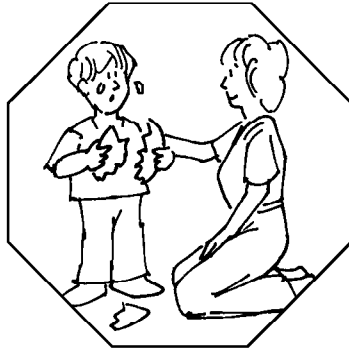
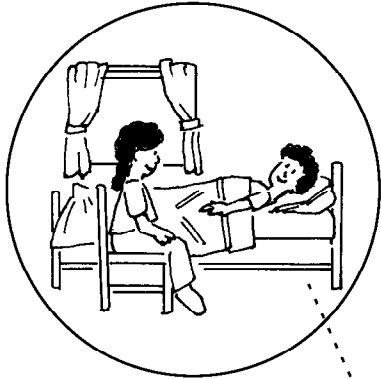
Family Bible Week!!!

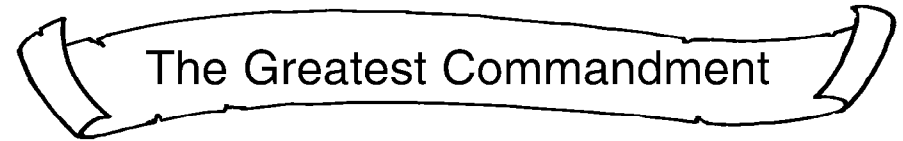

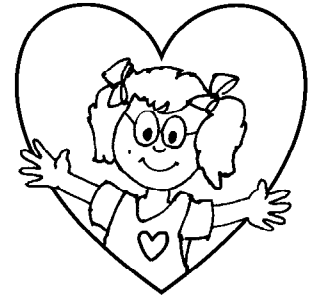
