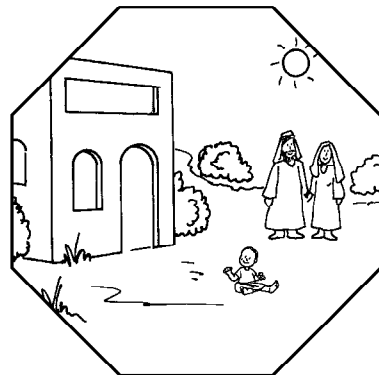
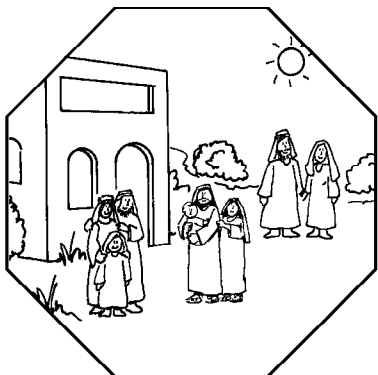
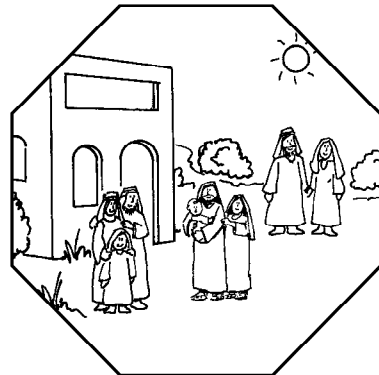
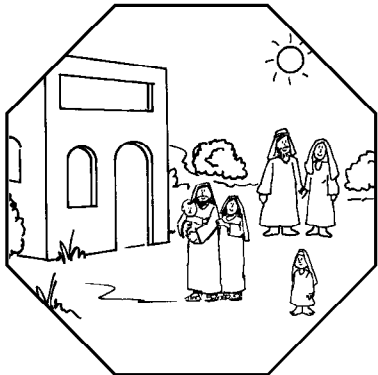
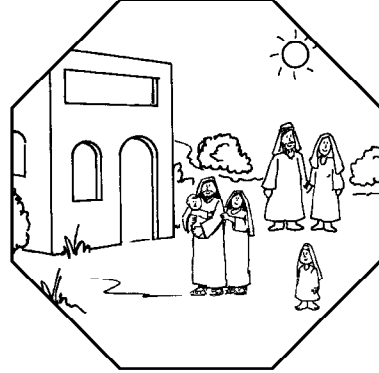
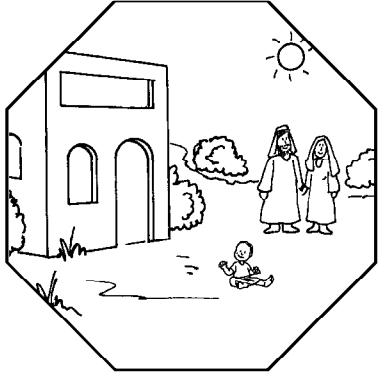
CHRISTMAS EVE

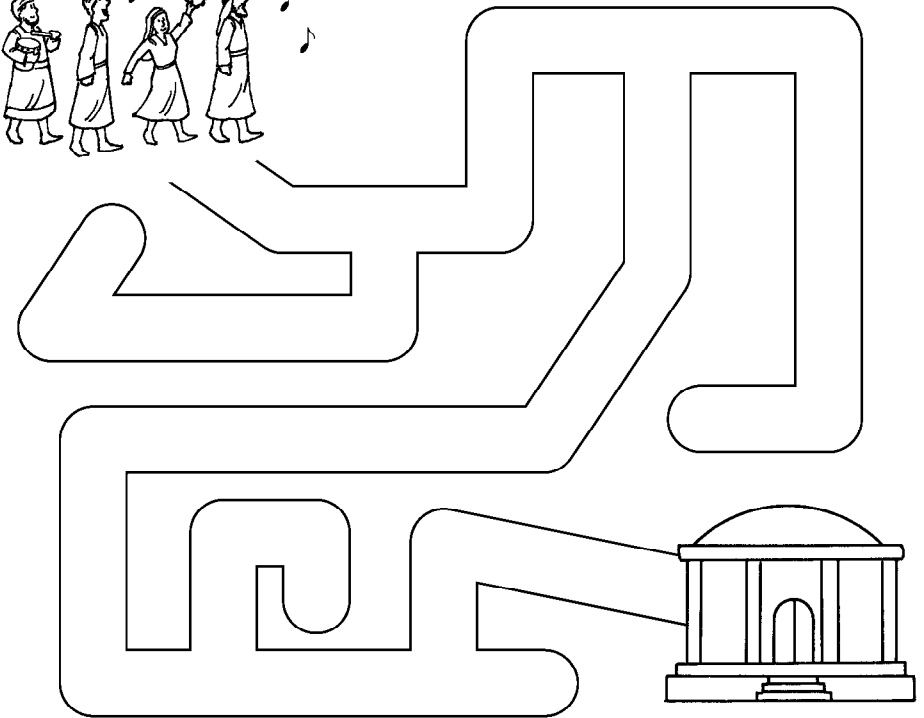
Ages 3-6

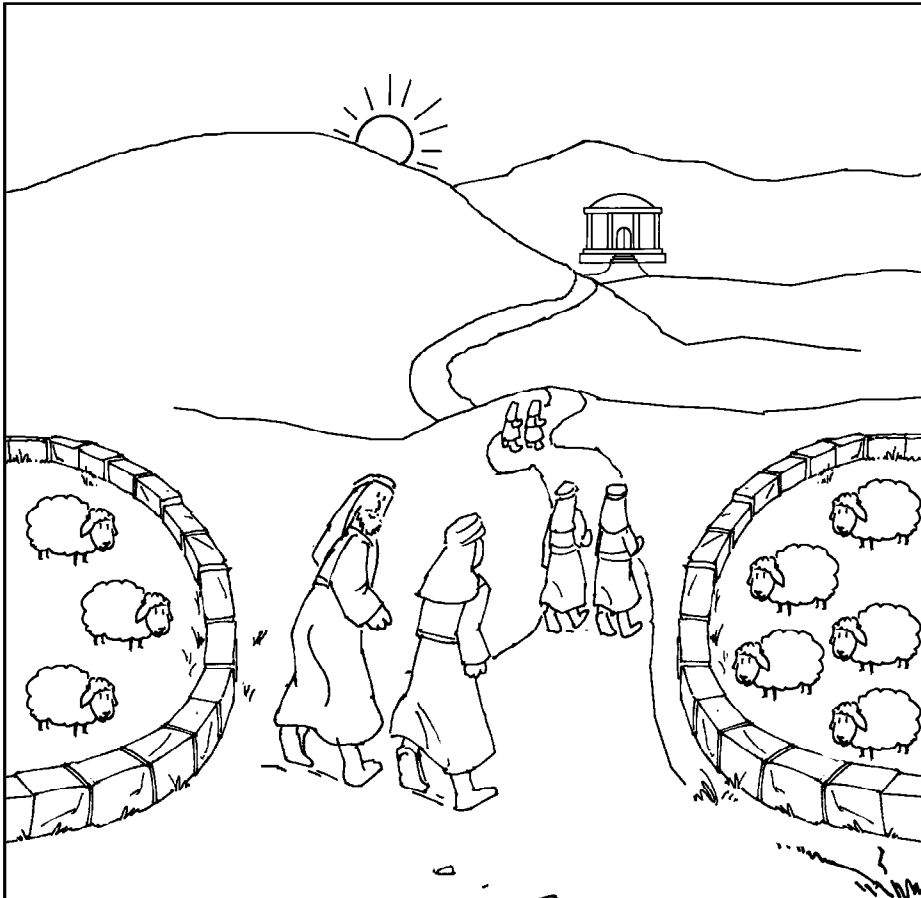
