LIFE TO THE DYING

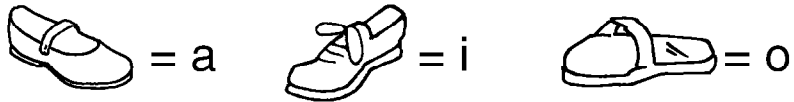
Over the Christmas season, the

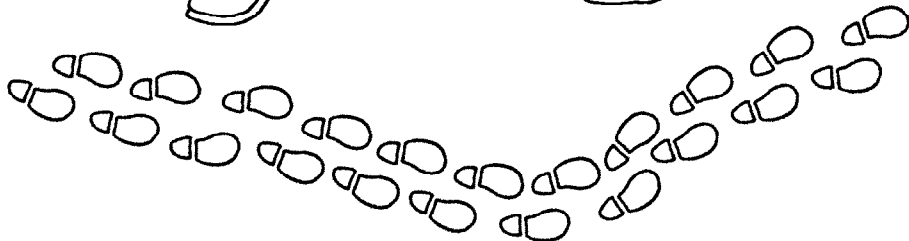

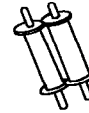

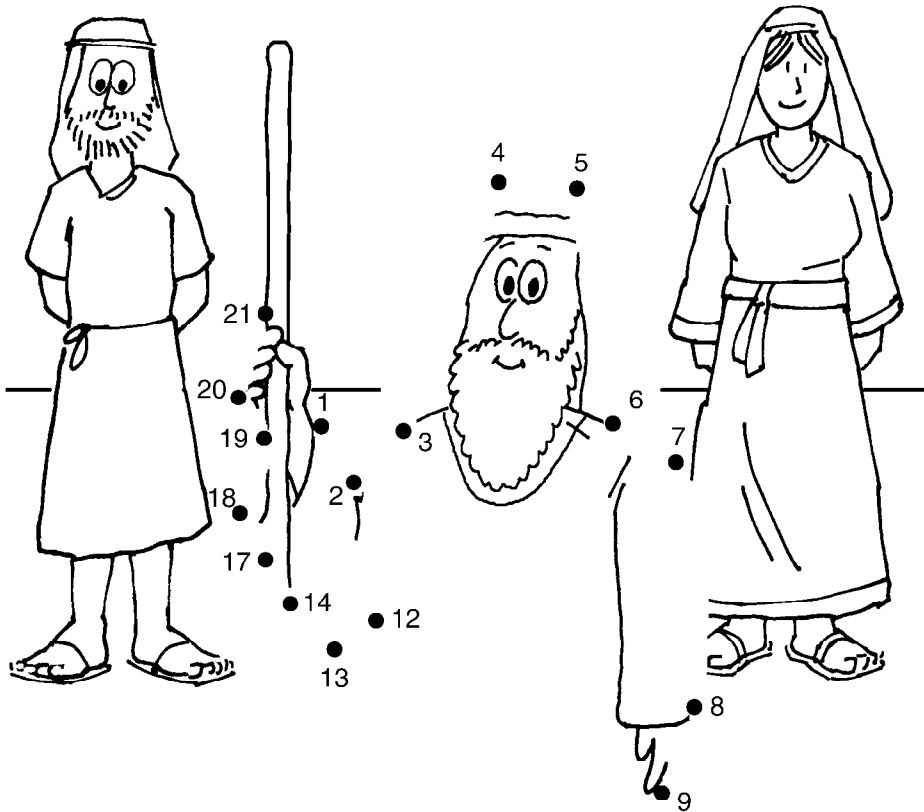
